

BSM teacher Jeremy Noller is coordinating the groups performing at Henry's for Performathon on May 19, 2018.

The usual "Blues Brunch" on Saturdays at Henry's features a harmonica player and pianist playing duo. For our Performathon collaboration, Henry has invited us to bring student groups to perform on their own, as well as collaborate with the house musicians. Our MAP Jazz Combo will be anchoring the performances, however all BSM students are encouraged to sign up, sit in and play!

Below, find the answers to some frequently asked questions that students may have.

### 1. What is the schedule?

10:30a - Student Set Up  
11:00a - HENRY's Opens for Brunch (Henry's has a delicious brunch menu!)  
11:30a Students Only Set, Yvonnick arrives  
11:45a Yvonnick sets up during set while grooving to the student set  
12:00p Blues Brunch featuring Yvonnick + Keith Brown on piano  
12:45p Students Only Set  
1:30p Break  
1:45p Open Session with Yvonnick, Keith + Students

### 2. I would like to sign up to play at Henry's and I'm not part of the MAP program. How many songs can I sit in on?

That will depend on how many students we have signed up by May 19. Right now there is space to sit in on multiple songs.

### 3. Do I need permission from my teacher(s) to participate? Can I participate if I am a beginner?

You should speak with your teachers and check in with Jeremy Noller (nollerjer@mac.com). Students need to be prepared to play the melody of a song (list below) and improvise a short solo on it. Even a beginner (to jazz) could learn to play the melody and solo on "Sonnymoon for Two"!

### 4. Can I perform if I don't rehearse with the group ahead of time?

This depends on your level. Check in with your teacher and Jeremy ahead of time and if they agree that you are prepared, then yes. If you are new to jazz, you should make time for a rehearsal.
