EXPANSION

In 2019, BSM dramatically expanded its adult classes, offering Dalcroze, beginner violin, beginner guitar, beginner piano, beginner ukulele, voice, and hand drumming.

STUDENT COMPOSING PROJECT

A4TY: Album for the Young, our student composing project was our last live event before going virtual, held at Symphony Space's Thalia Theater on March 7, 2020. Over 39 students composed new works for varied instrument combinations which were all performed at the concert by their peers on March 7. In addition, Pauline Kim Harris was commissioned to write a piece for 5 violins, performed by Naho Parrini and her students. Over 80 BSM students and faculty members participated in the project this year.









MUSIC ACCESS PROJECT (MAP)

Music Access Project offers talented students in underserved NYC communities a comprehensive music education at little to no cost.

A final chamber concert and Zoom event held in June 2020 served as a catalyst for students and their families to recognize the extraordinary journey of these young talented musicians. Alex Estrella was one of six graduating seniors in our MAP program. Alex has decided to attend NYU in the Fall, with a \$51,500 Scholarship and a double major in Violin Performance and Media & Communications.






DIGITAL ACCESSIBILITY





OUR TEACHING ARTISTS

The arts and culture sector has been disportionately affected by the COVID-19 crisis as New York City's cultural institutions, many of which our teaching artists who are professional musicians are also employed at, were forced to close.

BSM kept 100% of its personnel and teaching artists employed while also facilitating the transition to virtual teaching.

STAYING CONNECTED

In response to the call for social distancing BSM continued to gather our community by reimagining our spring gatherings as online events, including our two annual spring fundraising events, Performathon and the Spring Benefit which raise 4% of our yearly operating budget.


PERFORMATHON




