PROJECT BRIDGE

WHAT IS PROJECT BRIDGE?

Project Bridge gives motivated, music loving students an opportunity to grow on their instrument through private one on one lessons with a gifted teacher. Project Bridge offers a full tuition scholarship for weekly lessons to talented young musicians who would otherwise have difficulty affording them. This program supports students who participate in their middle or high school band, orchestra, or choir and helps them to grow into musical leaders in their school ensemble.

PROJECT BRIDGE PROVIDES:

- A 45-minute weekly lesson with a Bloomingdale teaching artist.
- Opportunities to perform both solo and in ensemble.
- Support and guidance from the Program Director including in the college audition process if you choose to continue music studies after high school.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Students with at least one year of experience on a band or orchestra instrument or singing in school ensemble
- Must be in 7th-10th grade at the time of the audition
- Must participate in school band, orchestra or choir throughout the school year
- Demonstrated financial need through completed financial aid form
